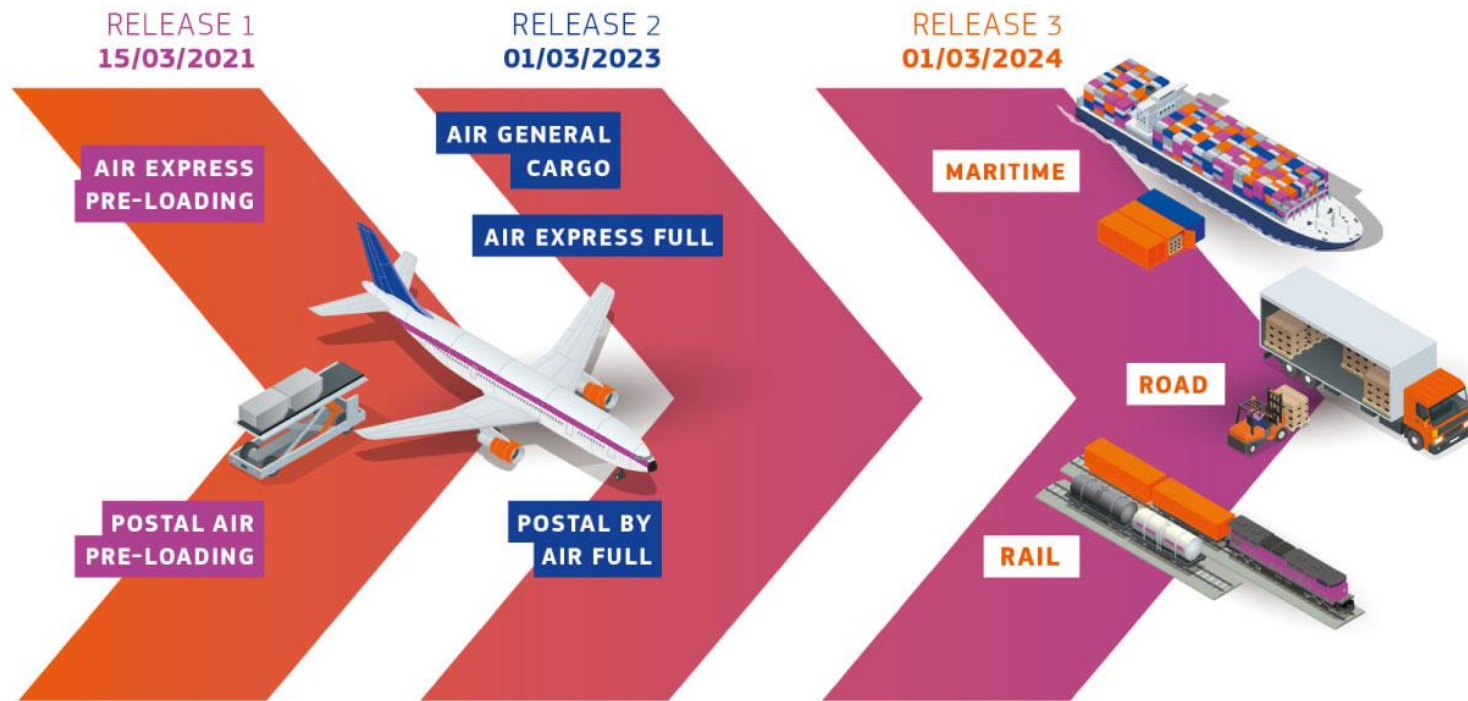


# ICS2 R2 Webinar with EO

- All consignments (postal, express, general cargo) transported to or via the EU will be subject to ENS filing requirements for 2 types of risk analysis:
  - Air pre-loading – aviation security only (PLACI)
  - Air pre-arrival – all security and safety related risks
- The entry process is built around these 2 phases of risk analysis.

# ICS2 R2 Webinar with EO

- Types of ENS filings - Postal consignments:
  - F43 and F44 – lodged by the postal operator in pre-loading phase, used for both pre-loading and pre-arrival RA
  - F42 – lodged by the carrier in the pre-arrival phase, used for pre-arrival RA



# ICS2 R2 Webinar with EO

- Types of ENS filings - Express consignments:
  - F32 – lodged by express operator in pre-loading phase, used for pre-loading risk analysis
  - F30 – lodged by express operator in pre-arrival phase, used for pre-arrival RA
  - F33 – lodged by express operator for express consignments on air cargo general in pre-arrival phase, used for pre-arrival RA
  - F31 – lodged by carrier for express consignments on air cargo general in pre-arrival phase, used for pre-arrival RA



# ICS2 R2 Webinar with EO

- Types of ENS filings - Air cargo general :
  - F24 – lodged by house level filer (HLF) in pre-loading phase, used for pre-loading RA
  - F23 – lodged by HLF in pre-loading phase, used for pre-loading RA
  - F25 – lodged by HLF in pre-loading phase, used for pre-loading RA (always with F23)
  - F22 – lodged by HLF in pre-arrival phase, used for pre-arrival RA
  - F26 - lodged by HLF in pre-loading phase, used for pre-loading and pre-arrival RA



# ICS2 R2 Webinar with EO

- Types of ENS filings - Air cargo general :
  - F20 – lodged by carrier in pre-loading phase, used for pre-loading and pre-arrival RA
  - F21 – lodged by carrier in pre-arrival phase, used for pre-arrival RA
  - F27 – lodged by carrier in pre-arrival phase, used for pre-arrival RA
  - F28 – lodged by carrier in pre-loading phase, used for pre-loading and pre-arrival RA (direct airway bill)
  - F29 – lodged by carrier in pre-arrival phase, used for pre-arrival RA (direct airway bill)

# Arrival notification

- Lodged by air carriers upon arrival at the COFE ( HR - directly via ICS2 STI).
- Relevant ENS for the arrived means of transport can be retrieved via three different references:
  - MRN (in most cases won't be used by carriers)
  - Master transport document references and Expected date and time of arrival
  - 'Entry key' composed from Conveyance reference number and Expected date and time of arrival
- Control recommendations are communicated by MS (if applicable).
- Notify Party for the Arrival.



# Presentation notification

- Express and air cargo general consignments will be presented only once at COFE – presentation will be done by carrier;
- Postal consignments will be presented twice:
  - COFE (presentation done by carrier);
  - MS of destination (presentation done by postal operator).



# Presentation notification

- ICS2 accepts presentation done at a level of:
  - MRN
  - MAWB
  - HAWB
  - Receptacle (carrier presentation only)
  - House consignment (postal operator presentation)
  - Container (if used)
